- 1) About 60 % of students participated in survey. 85 to 100 % of syllabus is covered in the class is opined by 68 % students. While 18 % of students answered that 70 to 84 % of syllabus covered in the class. About 6 % of students answered that 55 to 59 % of syllabus is covered. 6 % students says that 30 to 54 % of syllabus is covered in the class while 2 % think that below 30% syllabus is covered.
- 2) About 64 % of students think that the teacher prepare thoroughly. 30 % of students think that the teachers prepare satisfactorily, 0 % of students responded indifferently, while 6 % of students responded poorly. And 0% responded indifferently and won't teach at all.
- 3) Always effective ratings were given by 64 % of students, while 22% of students responded sometimes effective, while 8% of students think teachers are able to communicate just satisfactorily 4% students rated generally ineffective while 0% rated very poor communication.
- 4) Teachers approach to teaching was described very good by 36 % of students, whereas 40 % students described teachers approach as excellent. About 22 % of students remarked as good as , while 2 % as fair and 0 % as poor approach.
- 5) About 54 % of students find the internal evaluation process by the teacher as always fair and 22 % students found usually fair. 20 % of students found it sometime unfair, while 4 % of students remarked usually unfair and 0% responded unfair internal evaluation.
- 6) About 42 % of students approved that their performance in assignment is usually discussed. About 32 % of students think that their performance is discussed every time, 26 % of students rated that performance is assigned is sometimes discussed. 0 % of students voted for rarely, and 0% students rated rarely and never.
- 7) About 32 % of students approved that the institution takes active interest in promoting internship, students exchange and field visit opportunities for them regularly, whereas 38 % of students respond often, 24 % of students responded sometimes, 6 % rated rarely, while 0% responded never.
- 8) About 60 % students think that teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilities them in cognitive, social and emotional growth

- significantly and 18 % think that its very well and 16% says moderately, 6% of students think it as marginally while 0 % responded not at all.
- 9) About 62 % of students strongly agree that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. About 28 % students agree with it. About 10% students have neutral opinion, whereas 0% students disagree and strongly disagree respectively
- 10) About 44 % students agree that teacher inform them about their expected competencies, course outcome and program outcome every time and 30% students say that it happens usually. About 20% students think that teachers informs them sometimes, while 6% students responded rarely and 0% students says that it is never respectively.
- 11) About 48% students feel that their mentor does necessary follow up with an assigned task with them every time, and 30% students says usually, 8% students says sometime, 0% students responded rarely and never.
- About 68% students agree that the teacher illustrates concepts through example and application every time, and 26% students think that it happens usually, while 6% students says that the teachers illustrates concept through example and application sometimes and 0% says rarely and never respectively
- 13) About 34% students fully agree that the teachers identifies their strength and encourage them with providing right level of challenges, and 54% students says reasonably. 12% students think it partially, where 0% students responded slightly and unable to.
- About 3% students agree that it happens usually, 34% students think that it happens every time. 27% students think that teachers are some time able to identify their weakness and help them to overcome them. 9% students responded rarely and 0% never.
- About 30% students strongly agree that the institution makes effort to engage students in a monitoring review and continuous quality improvement of teaching learning process, whereas 54% students agree. About 14% students rated as neutral and about 2% students opted as disagree and 0% strongly disagree.
- 16) About 32% students says to a great extent, 46% students think that the institution and teacher use students centric method to a moderate level.

- About 22% students responded somewhat. About 0% students rated very little, and not all.
- About 32% students strongly agree that they receive encouragement from teachers to participate in extra curricular activities, and 54% students agree it. 14% students are neutral, while 0% students are disagree and strongly disagree respectively.
- About 32% students agree that to a great extent effort are made by the institution or teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work. Moderate efforts where observed by 54% students and 12% students opted somewhat, 2% very little, while 0% opted not at all.
- 19) About 34% students rated for above 90%, 22% of students opted for 70-89%, 22% students rated for 50-69%, 22% of students opted for 30-49% while 0% opted for below 29%.
