- 1) About 65 % of students participated in survey. 85 to 100 % of syllabus is covered in the class is opined by 60 % students. While 20 % of students answered that 70 to 84 % of syllabus covered in the class. About 14 % of students answered that 55 to 59 % of syllabus is covered. 6 % students says that 30 to 54 % of syllabus is covered in the class while 0 % think that below 30% syllabus is covered.
- 2) About 64 % of students think that the teacher prepare thoroughly. 30 % of students think that the teachers prepare satisfactorily, 0 % of students responded indifferently, while 6 % of students responded poorly. And 0% responded indifferently and won't teach at all.
- 3) Always effective ratings were given by 60 % of students, while 24% of students responded sometimes effective, while 10% of students think teachers are able to communicate just satisfactorily 4% students rated generally ineffective while 2% rated very poor communication.
- 4) Teachers approach to teaching was described very good by 20 % of students, whereas 52 % students described teachers approach as excellent. About 20 % of students remarked as good as , while 8 % as fair and 0 % as poor approach.
- 5) About 72 % of students find the internal evaluation process by the teacher as always fair and 20 % students found usually fair. 4 % of students found it sometime unfair, while 4 % of students remarked usually unfair and 0% responded unfair internal evaluation.

- 6) About 40 % of students approved that their performance in assignment is usually discussed. About 30 % of students think that their performance is discussed every time, 30 % of students rated that performance is assigned is sometimes discussed. 0% students rated rarely and never.
- 7) About 30 % of students approved that the institution takes active interest in promoting internship, students exchange and field visit opportunities for them regularly, whereas 34 % of students respond often, 30 % of students responded sometimes, 6 % rated rarely, while 0% responded never.
- 8) About 56 % students think that teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilities them in cognitive, social and emotional growth significantly and 20 % think that its very well and 14% says moderately, 10% of students think it as marginally while 0 % responded not at all.
- 9) About 58 % of students strongly agree that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. About 24 % students agree with it. About 14% students have neutral opinion, whereas 4% students disagree and 0% strongly disagree
- 10) About 38 % students agree that teacher inform them about their expected competencies, course outcome and program outcome every time and 34% students say that it happens usually. About 22% students think that teachers informs them sometimes, while 6% students responded rarely and 0% students says that it is never respectively.
- 11) About 52% students feel that their mentor does necessary follow up with an assigned task with them every time, and 48% students says usually, 2% students says sometime, 0% students responded rarely and never.
- 12) About 66% students agree that the teacher illustrates concepts through example and application every time, and 32% students think that it happens usually, while 2% students says that the teachers illustrates concept through example and application sometimes and 0% says rarely and never respectively
- 13) About 36% students fully agree that the teachers identifies their strength and encourage them with providing right level of challenges, and 56% students says reasonably. 8% students think it partially, where 0% students responded slightly and unable to.
- 14) About 34% students agree that it happens usually, 42% students think that it happens every time. 12% students think that teachers are some time able to identify their weakness and help them to overcome them. 9% students responded rarely and 3% never.
- 15) About 34% students strongly agree that the institution makes effort to engage students in a monitoring review and continuous quality improvement of teaching learning process, whereas 56% students agree. About 8% students rated as neutral and about 2% students opted as disagree and 0% strongly disagree.

16) About 38% students says to a great extent, 48% students think that the institution and teacher use students centric method to a moderate level. About 14% students responded somewhat. About 0% students rated very little, and not all.

17) About 40% students strongly agree that they receive encouragement from teachers to participate in extra curricular activities, and 48% students agree it. 12% students are neutral, while 0% students are disagree and strongly disagree respectively.

18) About 42% students agree that to a great extent effort are made by the institution or teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work. Moderate efforts where observed by 54% students and 2% students opted somewhat, 2% very little, while 0% opted not at all.

19) About 42% students rated for above 90%, 40% of students opted for 70-89%, 18% students rated for 50-69%, 0% of students opted for 30-49% and below 29%

20) About 38% students strongly agree that the overall quality of teaching – learning process in the institution is very good and 42% students agree. About 12% students are neutral, while 8% students are disagree, and 0% strongly disagree.
